

Physical Anthropology ANTH 215 (5 pts.)

**EXTRA CREDIT OPTION**

Up to 5 extra points (added to the final grade) may be earned by completing one of the following options:

- Anthropology Colloquium Series. Attend; take notes, and type a 1-2 page (double-spaced) summary of at least 5 different talks given during the current semester. The Colloquium normally meets on Thursdays from 3-4 PM. See the Department web site for a schedule of talks. There are also talks given outside the regular time/day for this series, which, with consent of the instructor, may be used as well to fulfill the extra credit option.
- Visit the Honolulu Zoo and complete Exercises 8.2, 8.3, & 8.4 in D. France's *Lab Manual and Workbook for Physical Anthropology* 7<sup>th</sup> edition. You may wish to take some photographs of your subject species. If this option is selected, make sure that you make observations of your study species for at least 1 hour. Plan on spending longer if you want to be sure of receiving full extra credit for this option.
- Exploring the web. Using a search engine, locate at least **10** reliable web sites that directly related to the material covered in this course. Submit **10** assignments following the format given below. Each web site must be unique and have a separate site URL (do not submit an extension of a site already submitted). The content of each site must be relevant to the course material (i.e. no ads. no commercial products or religious/ethnic propaganda such as creationist or racist sites). Full credit is given to those who have demonstrated they have searched wisely and have not just submitted what appeared on their first try. Your submission, which must be sent to Dr. Pietrusewsky by e-mail, must include the following:

Site title:

Site URL (<http://www.....>)

Who, or what organization, maintains the site.

Is it a credible site (i.e. can the information be trusted?). Explain.

Short description (about 250 words) how you found the site (key words, search engine e.g., Excite, Yahoo etc.), and a summary of the site's contents and how the site is related to the course material and what you learned by viewing/reading the information posted at this site.

- Film Review: Following the instructions for the former Film Review Assignment (see web pages for this course), prepare a typed review of 5 films in physical anthropology (30 minutes or more in duration).
